While planning these projects please remember that if you are performing any type of excavation please call 811 the national campaign number for “Know what’s Below. Call before you dig”.

Some customers may ask....What is Excavation? **Excavation refers to any operation involving movement of earth, rock or other materials below existing grade or surface level. Excavation can include digging, blasting, boring, driving, tunneling, and backfilling.**

Below are some types of excavation:



Driving, drilling, and hammering something like a post, T post, re-bar, concrete forming stakes, or rod into the ground. **Call 811 - “Know what’s Below. Call before you dig”.**



When using equipment to move the earth, dirt, or other materials. **Call 811 - “Know what’s Below. Call before you dig”.**

Follow These 5 Simple Steps to safe excavation:

- Plan your project
- Contact your 811 agency
- Wait for the marks
- Respect the marks
- Dig with care
